Middle Atlantic / Southeast College Tour: March 14 - 19, 2010

TOUR DESCRIPTION:

This six day / five night excursion will introduce you to several colleges and universities where you will have the chance to experience first-hand what college life is all about, become actively involved in obtaining accurate and reliable information, and have an exciting and educational time with your classmates and friends.

You will visit: University of Pennsylvania, Drexel University, or Swarthmore College; Johns Hopkins University, Goucher College, or Loyola University; University of Maryland; Georgetown University; American University or George Washington University; University of Richmond; University of Virginia; Davidson College or University of North Carolina at Charlotte; Wake Forest University or North Carolina School of the Arts; Duke University and University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill OR Guilford College and Elon University. (YOU CHOOSE SCHOOL TO VISIT WHEN GIVEN OPTION)

There will be student led campus tours, question and answer sessions with admission officers, meals, classroom visits, activities, and plenty of sightseeing. Lodging will occur in hotels located near the schools and is based on double occupancy. Activities on previous tours have included exploring the areas surrounding the schools, attending athletic and cultural events, and shopping in malls and markets. Throughout the trip, participants receive helpful information, materials, and tips on how to make the most of the campus visits.

Mrs. Kemp Hoversten and Mrs. Kim Stodghill, college counselors, Berkeley Preparatory School, FL, and Mr. Robert Rummerfield, Director of **COLLEGE VISITS** will lead the tour. Before starting **COLLEGE VISITS** in 1991, Mr. Rummerfield was an admissions officer at The Johns Hopkins University. The past seven years, Berkeley Preparatory students, Mrs. Hoversten, Mrs. Stodghill, and Mrs. Massari have participated on our tours. Some of their comments:
