## **Midwest College Tour: July 11 - 16, 2010**

### **Tour Description:**

This six day / five night excursion will introduce you to several colleges and universities. You will have the chance to experience first-hand what college life is all about, and have an exciting and educational time with your classmates and friends.

You will visit: University of Michigan; University of Notre Dame; University of Chicago or Loyola University; Northwestern University or De Paul University; University of Wisconsin at Madison; Beloit College; Purdue University; University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign; Washington University-St. Louis. There will be student led campus tours, meetings with admission officers, campus meals, overnight stays in college residence halls and hotels, activities, and plenty of sightseeing. Activities on previous tours have included exploring the areas surrounding the schools, attending special events, and shopping in malls and markets. Throughout the trip, participants receive helpful information, materials, and tips on how to make the most of the campus visits.

The trip will be led by representatives from **COLLEGE VISITS** and high school counselors. **COLLEGE VISITS** is directed and founded by Robert Rummerfield, who previously was an assistant director of admissions at The Johns Hopkins University.
