Tour Description

This seven day / six night excursion will introduce you to several colleges and universities. You will have the chance to experience first-hand what college life is all about, and have an exciting and educational time with your classmates and friends.

You will visit: McGill University; Concordia University; Carleton University; University of Waterloo or McMaster University; University of Guelph; University of Ottawa; Queen's University; Trent University; University of Toronto; York University. (YOU CHOOSE SCHOOL TO VISIT WHEN GIVEN OPTION).

There will be student led campus tours, meetings with admission officers, campus meals, overnight stays in college residence halls and hotels, activities, and plenty of sightseeing. Activities on previous tours have included exploring the areas surrounding the schools, attending special events, and shopping in malls and markets. Throughout the trip, participants receive helpful information, materials, and tips on how to make the most of the campus visits.

The trip will be led by representatives from **COLLEGE VISITS** and high school counselors. **COLLEGE VISITS** is directed and founded by Robert Rummerfield, who previously was an assistant director of admissions at The Johns Hopkins University. Since 1991, teenagers, parents, and counselors from across the world have joined our tours. Some of their comments:
