TOUR DESCRIPTION:

This seven day / six night excursion will introduce you to several colleges and universities. You will have the chance to experience first-hand what college life is all about, and have an exciting and educational time with peers and new friends.

You will visit: University of Oregon or Oregon State University; Willamette University or Western Oregon University; Linfield College or George Fox University; Pacific University or Lewis & Clark College; Portland State University or Warner Pacific College; University of Portland or Concordia University; Gonzaga University; Whitworth College; Seattle University or Seattle Pacific University; University of Washington; University of Puget Sound or Pacific Lutheran University. There will be student led campus tours, meetings with admission officers, campus meals, classroom visits, activities, and plenty of sightseeing. Overnight lodging will be in hotels. Activities on previous tours have included exploring the areas surrounding the schools, attending special events, and shopping in malls and markets. Throughout the trip, participants receive helpful information, materials, and tips on how to make the most of the campus visits.

The trip will be led by representatives from **COLLEGE VISITS** and high school counselors. **COLLEGE VISITS** is directed and founded by Robert Rummerfield, who previously was an admissions officer at The Johns Hopkins University.
